

Pupils and Curriculum Committee

Terms of reference:

- To consider and advise the Governing Body on standards and other matters relating to the school's curriculum, including statutory requirements and the School's Curriculum Policy.
- To consider curricular issues which have implications for Finance and to make recommendations to the relevant committee or the Governing Body.
- To advise and make recommendations to the Governing Body in matters pertaining to Safeguarding.
- To make arrangements for the Governing Body to be represented at School Improvement discussions with the Regional Schools Commissioner and for reports to be received by the Governing Body.
- To receive regular reports from the school's curriculum monitoring cycle and advise the Governing Body.
- To oversee arrangements for educational visits.
- To evaluate School Development Plan priorities relating to curriculum and recommendation to building resources.
- To scrutinise data regarding the progress and standards of pupils' work.
- To consider those aspects of governor business which involve staff and pupils.
- To be responsible for forming panels of governors to deal with staff appointments.
- To provide minutes and reports of all such meetings to the full governing body.
- To make recommendations to the Staffing, Finance and Resources committee and to the full governing body.
- To scrutinise information regarding the quality of teaching and learning, gathered from monitoring carried out within the school.
- To receive external audits of curriculum subjects, and Governor Visit reports.
- To review Sex Education policy annually.
- To review the Living and Learning Policy, and receive information about how this is enacted within the school.
- To amend and approve policies that affect pupils and the curriculum.
